# 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Homework

- Independent Daily Reading happens in class and at home. (more information in a moment!)
- Math is assigned by each math teacher based on unit being instructed.
- ELA and Content (Social Studies/Science/Health) will be assigned as needed, but not routinely.



# Independent Daily Reading (IDR)...

- Students self-select what they read.
- Students read at home and at school.
- There are NO TIME LIMITS or reading logs.
- Students will interact with the teacher about what they are reading.
- Students will write a bi-weekly response for a grade.



# 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Grading...

- All assignments are expected to be completed on time, neatly, with best writing skills or on the computer.
- Assignments and Grades will all be posted in CANVAS



# Snack

Students will be given time during ELA to have a quick snack. The snack should be:

- able to be eaten with a mask on
