Student Technology Use in Elementary School

Students may use their personal technology:

- When permitted by a teacher or administrator
- Before and after school

Devices must remain off and in backpack at all other times

Personal devices are *not* required for school

All students are issued a school system laptop

- **K-1**: HCPSS laptops remain at school
- Grades 2-5: Students bring HCPSS laptops back and forth


