## JA in a Day Volunteers Needed

We are very excited to continue our partnership with Junior Achievement of Central Maryland. Junior Achievement is a worldwide organization that has local chapters throughout the United States including Junior Achievement of Central Maryland. Junior Achievement offers a variety of programs including JA in a Day. JA in a Day is an initiative that allows parent and community volunteers to teach all of the lessons of Junior Achievement's six elementary school programs in an effective one-day effort. Our JA in a Day at Clemens Crossing will take place on Wednesday, March 15, 2017.

During the course of JA in a Day, students will learn about various aspects of financial literacy, work readiness, and entrepreneurship. For instance, students in second grade will learn about "Our Community" and will have a chance to see how money moves through a community, creating jobs, and generating tax proceeds that pay for schools, parks, and streets. In fifth grade, students will study "Our Nation," where they will begin to learn about economic concepts such as opportunity cost and supply and demand. The themes and concepts align with social studies topics in addition to many other connections to our curriculum.

We want to thank the PTA for helping secure volunteers for this initiative. They are coordinating two volunteers for each classroom for a total of 48 volunteers school-wide. We would like to have all of our volunteers scheduled by the end of February. The volunteers will teach five lessons throughout the day, and they will bring real-world background and



experiences into the lessons. All volunteers will receive a kit of hands-on materials and lesson plans tailored to their assigned grade level during a mandatory training session. New volunteers must attend one of two training sessions prior to JA in a Day. If you volunteered last year for JA in a Day, the training is optional. The training sessions will take place on Monday, February 27 9:30-10:30 a.m. or Monday, February 27 from 7:00-8:00 p.m. The success of the program is based upon the volunteers in our school and our community.

## Kindergarten and New First Grade Registration
