# 5th Grade Academics...

# 5th Grade Homework...

- Independent Daily Reading happens in class and at home. (more information in a moment!)
- Math is assigned by each math teacher based on unit being instructed.
- ELA and Content (Social Studies/Science/Health) will be assigned as needed, but not routinely.

Homework in elementary school is NOT part of academic grades.

# Independent Daily Reading

- Students **self-select** what they read.
- Students read **at home and at school**.
- There are **NO TIME LIMITS** or reading logs.
- Students will **interact with the teacher** about what they are reading.



# 5th Grade Grading...

- All assignments are expected to be completed on time, neatly, with a student's best writing skills.
- Grades will all be posted in Canvas within 3 weeks, according to HCPSS guidelines
- Checking Canvas often is a skill we will build this year.
