5th Grade Academics...

5th Grade Homework...

- <u>Independent Daily Reading happens in class and at home.</u> (more information in a moment!)
- <u>Math</u> is assigned by each math teacher based on unit being instructed.
- <u>ELA and Content</u> (Social Studies/Science/Health) will be assigned as needed, but not routinely.

Homework in elementary school is NOT part of academic grades.

Independent Daily Reading

- Students self-select what they read.
- Students read at home and at school.
- There are NO TIME LIMITS or reading logs.
